Due to the severe global situation of the ongoing uncertainty created by the rapid spread of COVID-19 which have seriously compromised National and International events in so many countries, the organization of Kigali International peace Marathon took a prudent precaution & the decision to postpone the 16th Edition of Kigali International Peace Marathon, which was scheduled for May 17, 2020 and is moved to 21st June 2020. At this time, all events associated with the Kigali International Peace Marathon are also re-scheduled and their new dates shall be communicated soon. In the extremely unlikely event that current health concerns continue, we will take extraordinary measures to ensure a safe environment for the race or we will inform if the event is cancelled. In the meantime, we encourage all to strictly adhere to the health authorities' guidelines regarding personal hygiene and appropriate social distancing.
